Before care is offered from 7:15am-8am and includes breakfast, morning prayer, table activities and a weekly grade level Saint Focus an additional fee of \$35 per child or \$50 per family for the year is charged for this program.

**Hearts of Fire Program* is a two-year combined 7th and 8th grade Religious Education Class that uses curriculum textbooks as guides for students to learn their faith. Classes welcome the energy and excitement of the middle school years with hands-on games, faith topic discussions and the opportunity for pre-teens to learn about their faith and embrace it in their own way.

Nazareth Family Homeschool: Families receive textbooks and mini lesson plans to cover the lessons. Each Lesson requires a virtual portal assignment. Families teach their children the lessons with the help of the recorded lessons on their own schedule. A pacing guide is provided. Bi-monthly family sessions will be held at Holy Family and families attend for a time of prayer, learning and activities. Full participation is required. During the school year 6 stay connected to the parish activities are required. A monthly schedule will be published. Virtual and in person opportunities will be offered.

Intensive Summer Virtual Programs

Summer Religious Education Classes are offered in a condensed format where students cover their grade level year of material, 25 classes, in a 5 or 10 day program. Full participation in classes is required. During the school year 6 stay connected to the parish activities are required to complete the grade level. A monthly schedule will be published. Virtual, at home and in person opportunities will be offered.

Summer Session 1 Week Model: 8am-2:30pm Monday-Friday. Students receive a textbook and log in through a googlemeet link and are taught by a Catechist, (teacher). A mixture of textbook lessons, breaks and at home activities are included. Virtual Portal work and additional resources are also included. Hands on materials will be sent home with textbooks and families host the alternate games, crafts, family prayer times etc. Additional googlemeets will also be available. Daily mass is included; virtual or in person. Pre-recorded and optional in person church tours, presentations and talks are also included. Families accompany children for in person offerings. *Class size is limited to 15 virtual students per grade for quality interaction*

Summer Session 2 Week Model: Families receive textbooks and mini lesson plans to cover the lessons. Each Lesson requires a virtual portal assignment. Families teach their children the lessons with the help of the recorded lessons on their own schedule. A family pacing guide is provided. Daily virtual activities are hosted and available to log in for, that encompass prayer, service projects, games etc. 15 activities will be offered and 5 are required over the 10 day program. Daily mass is included; virtual or in person. Pre-recorded church tours, presentations and talks are also included. All work is due by the last day of the program, 7/2 or 8/27 at 8pm.
