Below are registration guidelines for your review.

Registration fees are: \$160.00 for the first child, \$290 for 2 children and \$350 for 3 or more children. All programs carry the same registration fee. Fees include class materials and a variety of activities during the year.

Registration Fees for children enrolled in Sunday morning Pre-K – K classes are \$35.00 per student.

Fall Classes begin the week of September 26th 2021 .

REGISTRATION GUIDELINES

1. Children are admitted to class when the Religious Education Office has received each student's completed registration form, stay connected activity sheet, if needed, and fees. Payment in full is due when registration forms are handed in. Registration forms received without payment cannot be processed nor the student(s) placed in class. 2. A valid copy of a child's Baptismal Certificate must accompany a first time registration form.
3. Families who are registering students as transfers from another Faith Formation program or Catholic school must include a letter from the transferring parish/school affirming the child/children's consistent attendance.
4. Families should be participating in the sacramental life of the Church by attending weekly Mass.
5. Sacramental Preparation is a separate program from Religious Education Classes and will begin in the fall of the sacramental year.
